## **Course Description**

Piano Lab is designed to develop the basic skills necessary to be a successful performer and overall musician; through the study of music theory, vocabulary, historical references, performance opportunities, and creative composition. - 5. Demonstrate proper playing technique on the piano.
- 6. Perform in a variety of settings.
- 7. Analyze piano performances, compositions, and products using critical terminology.
